OHP) education across Europe



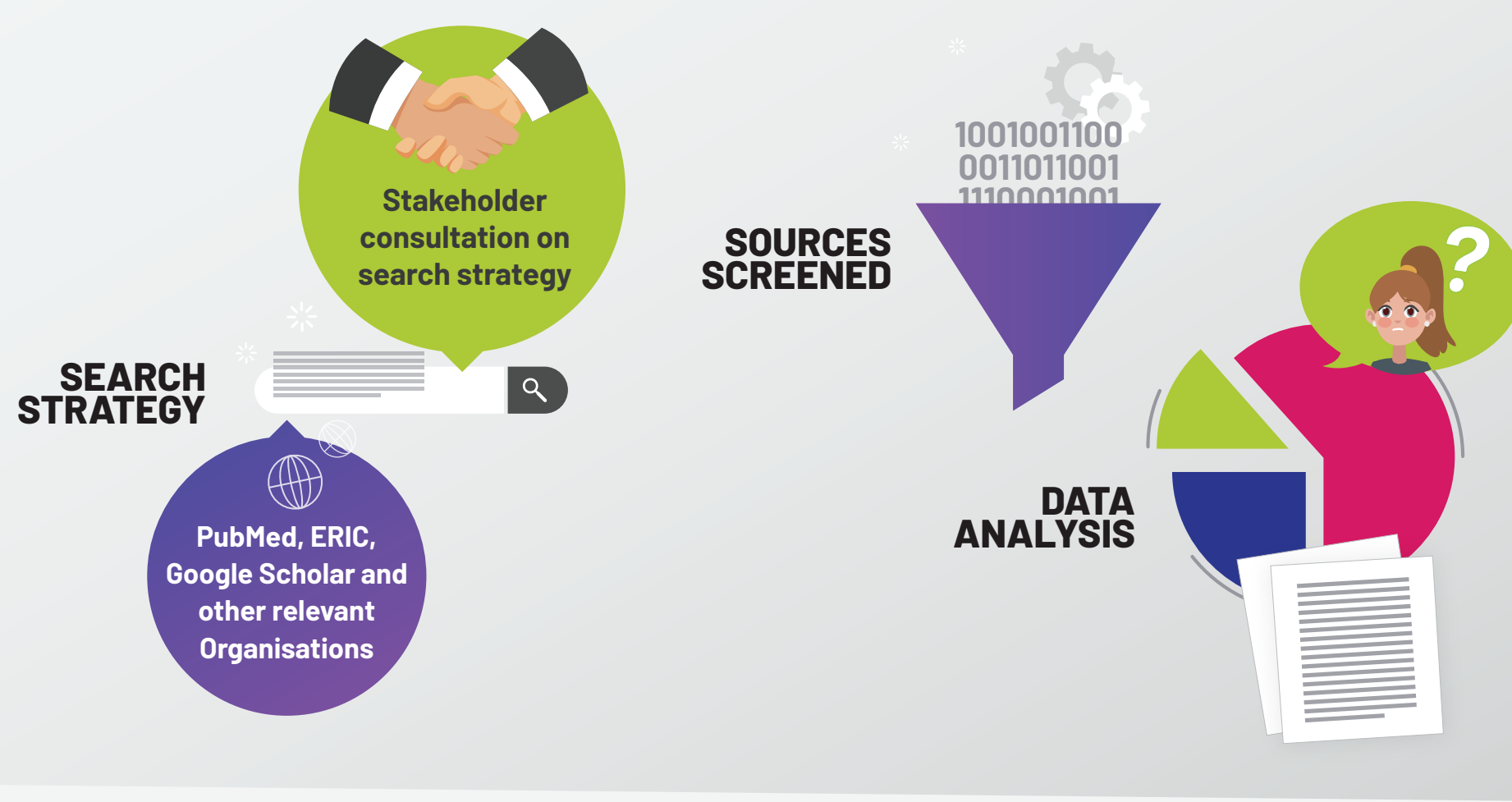

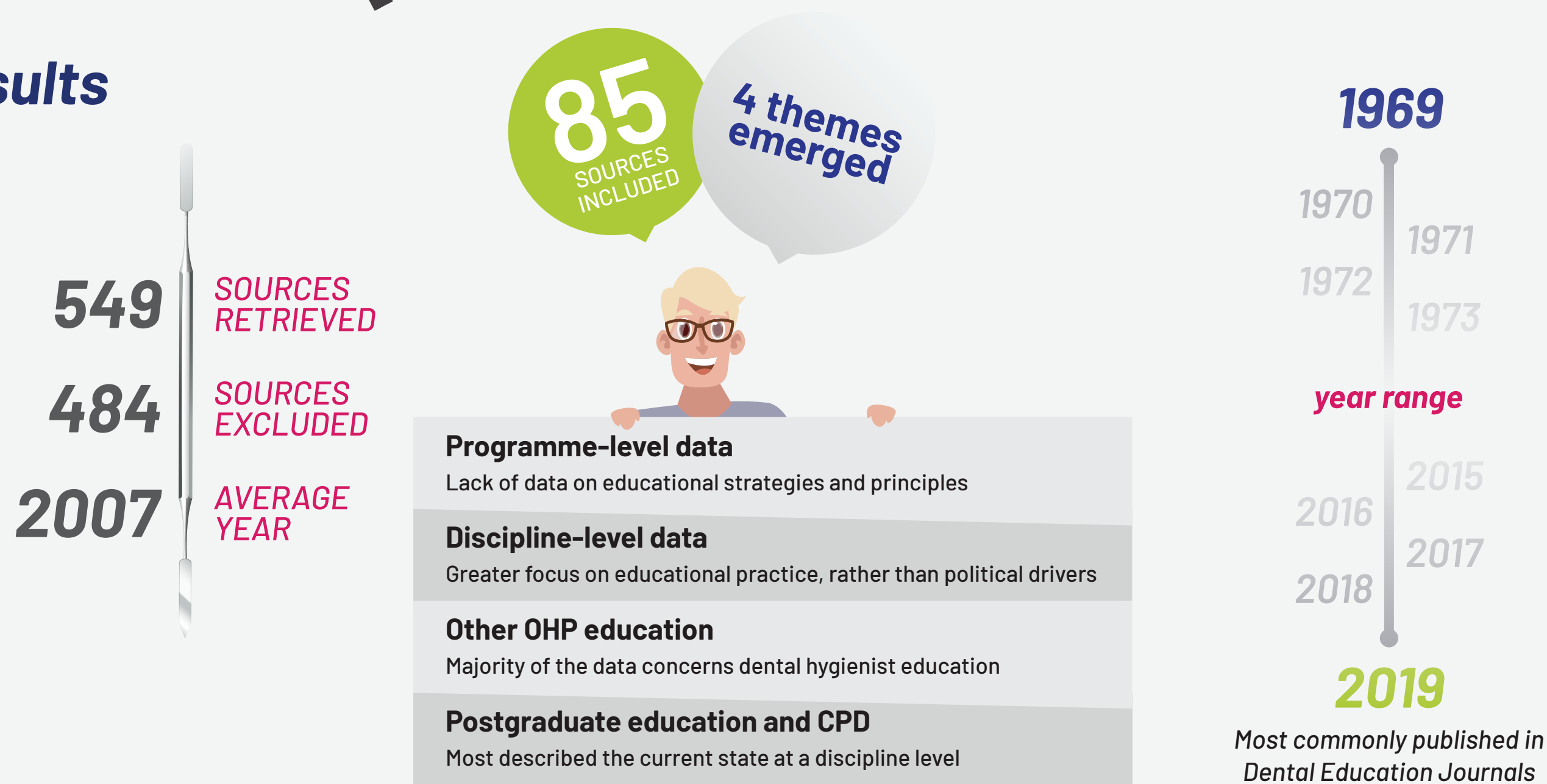

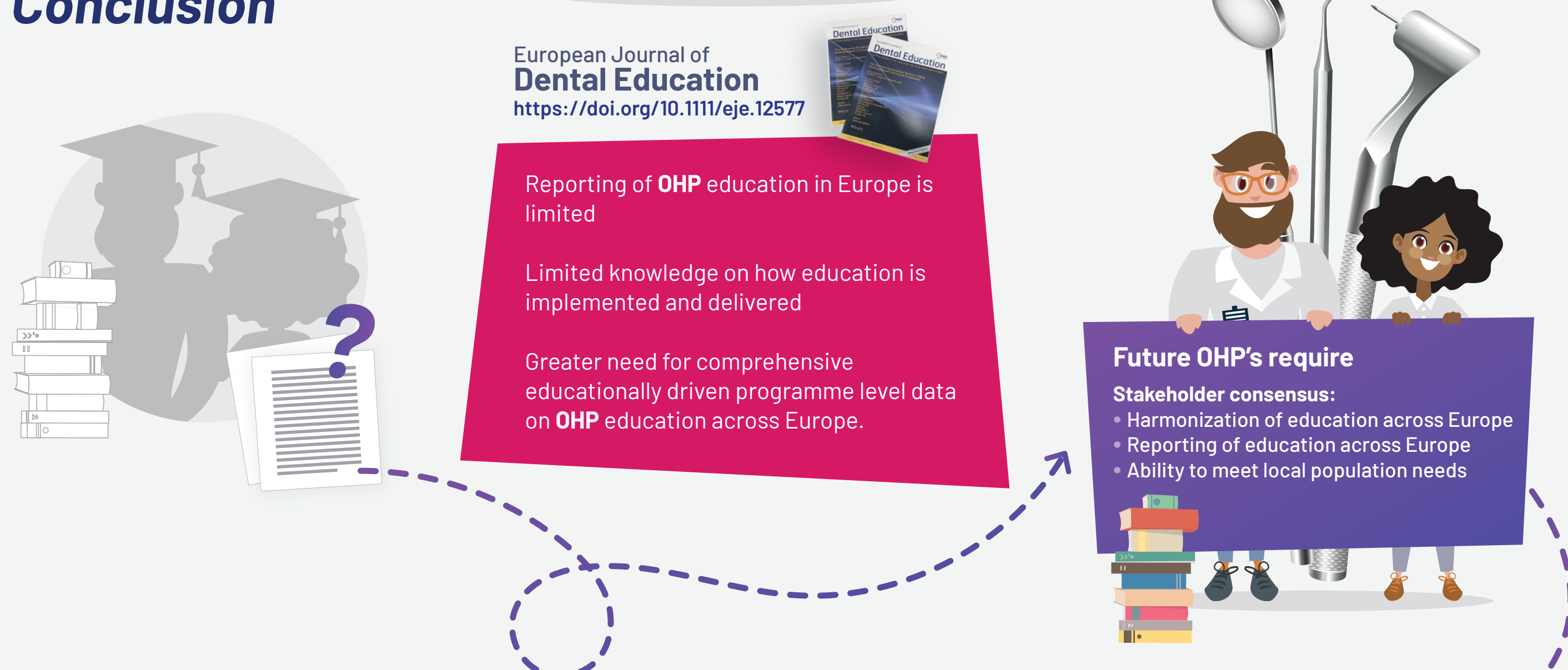
