Background/problem

Many terms used in educational settings are poorly defined or have different meanings in different countries. This could make data from a pan-European questionaire unreliable.





Primary Aim: To develop a glossary of terms concerning higher education of oral health professionals (OHPs) in Europe

Secondary Aim: To create a resource to improve the accuracy of replies to our questionaire





Kick-off workshop:

- 1. Agreement that terms used in questionaire (stage 1) will take priority
- Glossary will be expanded to include other terms required for questionaire stage 2 or poorly defined in other contexts for OHP education





Work Plan:

- 1. Identify terms that we will use in the first questionaire (sources *e.g.* Eugene's questionaire, draft of our questionaire, brainstorming, GED document)
- 2. Distribution of a subset of terms to members of the group for definition
- 3. Collation of terms





Barcelona:

- 1. Around 75 terms currently identified
- Discussion concerning how we should define terms (use current references or make new definitions?). Issue – publication of novel work vs compilation of others' definitions
- 3. Discussion of terms within expert group to reach consensus about definitions
- Identification of new terms to be defined





Going forward:

- 1. Further brainstorming within expert group
- 2. Stakeholder consultation Strasbourg
